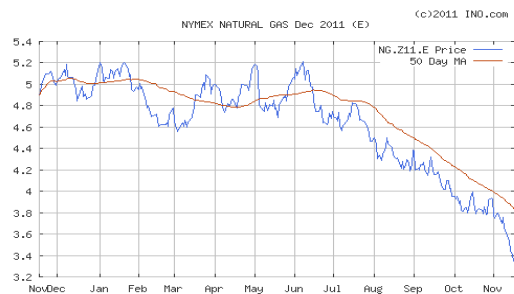

Market Natural gas traded lower during the week with oil rising given the weak dollar and European financial problems. Weather will eventually influence prices but storage is approaching full levels; and there was still an injection this week. Usually, rig counts rise in the winter but we have another big reduction this week. Prices continue to be tempered by flat industrial demand, a sluggish economy and moderate temperatures. Gas production levels due mostly to shale drilling are still strong. Natural gas is very attractive to fix at this time to protect this winter and beyond. The North American rig count is 877 this week which is a decrease of 30 from last week.

The Crude oil price for December is higher this week at \$99.53 per barrel. Heating oil is lower at \$3.10 per gal. Unleaded gasoline futures are lower this week at \$2.52 and gasoline at the pump is around \$3.59...in Indiana. The natural gas storage report today was an injection of 19 BCF; storage is **14 BCF higher** than last year and **224 BCF higher** than the 5 year average.



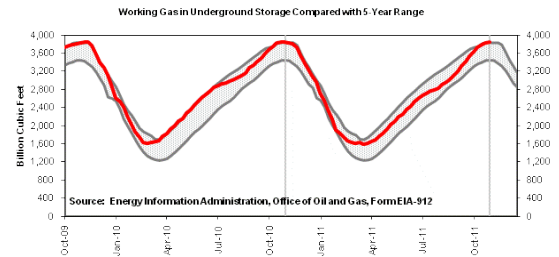
Above Graph – Dec 2011 NYMEX gas futures

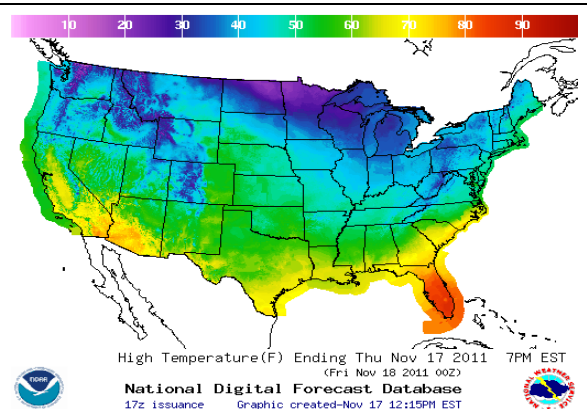
Typical Fixed Price for Winter
